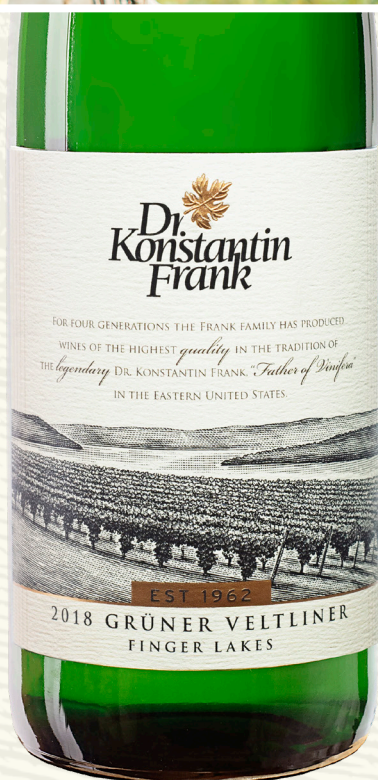

## What is Gruner Veltliner?

A white grape from the country of Austria where it is the most planted grape variety.

## What does it taste like?

Gruner Veltliner can be compared as an exotic alternative to Sauvignon Blanc with flavors of lime, citrus, and spice.

## How did we discover Gruner?

Frederick Frank of Dr. Konstantin Frank Winery became a fan of Gruner Veltliner while studying in Europe in the early 1980s. He had a hunch that the grape would thrive in the cool climate of the Finger Lakes. He searched for 2 decades for the right vineyard site and then in 2007 planted the first Gruner Veltliner vines on Seneca Lake.

## When should you drink this wine?

A sessionable white wine that's perfect for Spring and Summer. It's best served ice-cold on a hot summer day at picnics, BBQ's, beaches, and lakeside.
